Security & Preparedness Starts With You

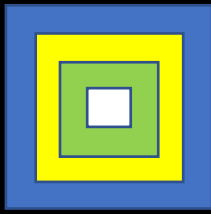


- **YOU**

 - Know how to get help and what to expect from



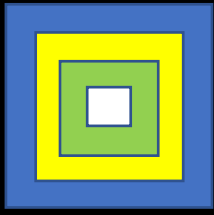
